
Thinking about installing it yourself?

Whether you are a natural do-it-yourselfer, or if you are looking to cut your costs on installation, installing your own fence can be a simple and rewarding experience. To make it a little easier - here is a quick guide that covers the fundamentals of fence installation.

Before You Start:

- Confirm your property line
- Locate underground utilities
- Research local zoning codes and restrictions
- Check for obstructions

Make Your Preperations

1. Set up Fence Area

Put a stake in the ground at each corner of the desired fence area, and one every 8 feet (if using 6' sections, put stake every 6'), as that is where the posts will go.

2. Decide on Gates

Think about where you would place your gate. Put a stake in the ground at the corners of each gate. The most common gate widths are 3′, 4′, and 5′.

3. Determine Number of Sections

Measure the total length of the fence and divide by 8, as most panells are sold in 8' sections. (If using 6' sections, divide by 6).

4. **Determine Posts**

Count the number of different posts you will need. (refer to diagram above)

Install Your Fence

1. Gather Tools

You will need the following for your installation (you can rent these from hardware stores): Torpedo level, circular saw, ready mix concrete, post hole digger, digging bar, stakes and string.

2. Install

Starting with corner or end post; dig holes 6"-12" in diameter and 24"-36" deep. use the center-tocenter measurements of the fence style. dig next hole. (Suggest not digging more than 1 hole ahead). Set post to plumb, tamp and secure then insert section. Repeat. Upon completion check line to see if you need to raise or lower posts.
